Mark your calendars for Saturday, June 25th for a **Wein Tasting with Food Pairing** led by DLT member Cheryl Richards. Cheryl has been trained through WSET – Wine & Spirit Education Trust at the 2nd of 3 levels in Wines. The

event will start at 6:00 pm in the Great Hall. Cost is \$45.00. Tasting includes samples of 8 German weins (or Ohio wein made from Grapes from Germany) including Gewürztraminer, Mosel Riesling, Pinot Noir, Dry Rose, Sarstein Riesling, Dornfelder, Dry Riesling, and an Ohio winery using grapes from Germany. Food pairings include wurstsalat, cheese recommended by St. Anne's Cheese Co, breads from Good Hands Bread, landjaeger, currywurst, and a Black Forest mini cupcake. German Folk Dance Lessons


